
## TAMALPAIS VALLEY






AN OAK-STUDDED KNOLL


A RESTFUL SLOPE



rapidly commanding the consideration they so well deserve. The Bolinas road forms their approach, and on it fronts our townsite—a townsite to which the whole of TAMALPAIS VALLEY is tributary. These and other natural advantages will make this limited area valuable for business, and here alone will business structures be permitted. Road work is now being done, and water mains will be installed. Instead of setting an amount which must be expended upon any home to be erected in TAMALPAIS VALLEY, CRANSTON, BELVEL & DWYER will insist that the exterior plans for each house meet with their approval. :: It is often possible to erect a pretty little bungalow for a few hundred dollars, something that will fit in with the surroundings and be an ornament to the property; whereas placing a restriction as to the cost, and permitting the owner to build without having his plans passed upon, makes it






## TAMALPAIS UNION HIGH SCHOOL

WITHIN ten minutes of Tamalpais Valley, and designed to serve Mill Valley, Tamalpais Valley and Sausalito. J. W. Dolliver, the Architect has admirably adapted the monastic style prevalent in Spanish highlands, a country similar in climate and ruggedness to beautiful Marin.

Tamalpais Union High School is being built at Mill Valley Junction and will be completed and ready for occupancy in August, 1908. Including furnishings it will cost close to \$50,000.




TAMALPAIS UNION HIGH SCHOOL
