OK FOR RECYCLING

Paper

Books (paperback)
Boxes, packages
Carbonless paper
Cardboard (cut to fit in cart)
Catalogs

Colored and construction paper

Egg cartons (paper only; no Styrofoam)
Envelopes with metal clasps
Envelopes with plastic windows
Frozen food packages
Gift wrap (non-metallic)
Junk mail
Magazines
Manila folders
Newspapers and inserts
Office paper
Paper (adhesive/post-its)
Paper bags

Paper packaging with remnant tape
Paper towel and toilet paper tubes
Pet food bags
Ribbon
Shredded paper (in a paper bag)
Telephone books
Tissue paper (gift type)

Metal

Aerosol cans (empty)
Aluminum cans
Aluminum foil (clean)
Aluminum pie plates
CRV beverage cans
Food cans (clean)
Pet food cans
Steel cans
Tin cans

Glass

Rinsed; all colors; lids, caps OK
Bottles
CRV beverage containers
Jars

Plastic

Containers only; empty; rinsed; with chasing arrows #1-#7; lids, caps OK
Bleach bottles
Buckets without handles
CRV beverage containers (soda, water, juice)
Detergent bottles
Food containers
Household cleaning containers
Lids and caps
Milk jugs
Salad dressing bottles (rinsed)
Shampoo and cream rinse bottles
Water jugs

REMINDERS

- Collections are **WEEKLY** on the same day as your garbage service.
- Place all recyclables in the gray recycling cart.
- Be sure all materials fit inside the cart with lid closed.
- Before discarding, consider reusing or donating.

DO NOT RECYCLE

- Ceramics, window glass, drinking glasses and light bulbs.
- Food, garbage and organic or green waste materials.
- Plastic bags. Return to the grocery store for recycling or use them to toss garbage.
- Styrofoam or polystyrene packing peanuts.
- Metal pipe or plumbing fixtures or appliances.
- Hazardous waste.



Leave 3 feet of space between carts.



Place at the curb by 5 a.m. or the night before.
